Observer report

On 9 and 10 September, I had the opportunity to attend the judging phase of the 2023 competition in Oftringen (AG) as an observer. Over the course of two days, I was thus able to view the unfolding of a nationwide competition from a different perspective; an experience that I recommend to everyone who takes part in PhotoSuisse competitions.

Some figures

This year, competition participants submitted 299 colour prints, 234 b/w prints, 519 digital colour photos, 412 digital b/w photos, 85 colour portfolios and 60 b/w portfolios. Compared to last year, the average increase was about 30%.

Following a scheme prepared by the competition organisers, these 4 photographers took turns in groups of 3 to assess the individual subcategories.

The evaluation procedure

On Saturday morning the jury evaluated all colour and b/w prints. In the late afternoon, the colour portfolios were judged. By Saturday evening, the colour and b/w prints accepted, awarded and best in category, as well as the portfolios accepted, awarded and the best colour portfolio were defined.

On Sunday morning, the b/w portfolios were first assessed and the accepted and awarded portfolios and the best b/w portfolio were finalised.

As a matter of timing, all digital photos were pre-evaluated by the jury members at home before this two-day event. On Sunday, the digital photos accepted and

awarded were therefore already known. Late Sunday morning the jury only had to choose the best digital colour and b/w photos.

Coordination of the judging procedure

Coordination was professionally ensured by competition manager Chris Brunner and his staff; a big thank you for this enormous performance and the great amount of preparation work carried out, without which it would not be possible to judge such a large number of images in two days.

I, as an observer, confirm that, during the two days I attended, everything was carried out according to the instructions and rules laid down in the competition regulations and that during the judging phase no image was either favoured or disadvantaged.
